Year 11 Uniform 2017 - 2018

It has become custom for some years at Chailey School for Year 11 to have the privilege of wearing white shirts in place of the Chailey blue shirts. Our student voice research has indicated that students would like to continue with this and I am happy to agree. Therefore, from September 2017 students may wear a white shirt. All other normal standards of uniform should be adhered to including rules concerning jewellery and piercings. As a reminder:

- Skirts should be no shorter than the long length of a credit card above the knee
- Trousers should be formal (chino style trousers are not permitted)
- Shoes should be plain black and of a leather type material (no canvas shoes or shoes with logos)
- We allow one stud in the lobe of each ear – no other piercings are allowed, including at the top of the ear
- A necklace of a religious nature is allowed, but no other forms of jewellery are permitted
- Natural coloured hair only
- Clear nails (no coloured nail varnish or false nails)

Year 11 are role models to other, younger students in the school and set the tone in terms of attitude, ambition, work ethic, behaviour and uniform. I know I can count on your support in ensuring Year 11 set the standards very high.
