Dear Parents and Carers

As we approach the end of the summer term I thought it sensible to drop you a communication about uniform expectations and our commitment to our formal school uniform. The introduction of the Chailey Community Card has certainly had the effect of 'smartening' the school community and I would like to thank you for your ongoing support with uniform.

There are, however, a small number of ways in which a significant minority of students are bending/breaking some uniform rules. We have written to the parents of individual students where we have specific concerns but I thought it important that all parents are aware of requirements.

- Trousers must be navy formal and tailored - chino type trousers are not acceptable
- Skirts must be the regulation style and no shorter than the long length of a credit card above the knee
- Shoes must be black and made of leather type material (no canvas, no trainers with logos, no boots and no metal toe caps)
- Only one piercing in the ear lobe of each ear is acceptable - no other piercings may be worn in school
