Dyslexia Awareness Week 2017

This week Chailey School has been supporting Dyslexia Awareness Week 2017. The theme this year is Positive Dyslexia and we have embraced this with a 'Positive Dyslexia' poster campaign. All teaching rooms have displayed posters with positive quotations about dyslexia, as well as our own Chailey Dyslexia Awareness poster designed by Year 7 dyslexic learners with its slogan: "Having a learning difference doesn't need to hold you back. Recognise what you're good at and how you learn best." Tutors have been discussing dyslexia positively with their tutor groups, encouraging our students to recognise dyslexia as a learning difference rather than a difficulty.

Our newly appointed dyslexia ambassadors (two from each year group) will now provide an important voice for the dyslexic learners in our school. They will meet formally with teachers every month to share ideas about effective strategies for improving learning and motivation and collaborate on new initiatives to support students challenged by dyslexia.

This week has also seen the launch of the 15 Minute Club: a weekly lunchtime club for our new Year 7 dyslexic learners run by the dyslexia ambassadors and Ms Hopkinson, our specialist dyslexia teacher. The club offers a space for students to meet, play games, complete homework, swap dyslexia-friendly reading books and share ideas. The name of the club, chosen by students, was inspired by a reading statistic: "If you read for just 15 minutes a day you will read up to 1,000,000 words every year." The club aims to get all students who attend on track with their reading and feeling good about themselves and school.

Continuing to improve provision for our SEND students is a key aim of Chailey's Strategic Plan. We are currently working towards achieving dyslexia-friendly status beginning with the English Faculty later this term. Last month all teaching staff completed Dyslexia awareness training and now we share a common goal that all lessons will incorporate dyslexia-friendly techniques to ensure that our dyslexic learners are given every opportunity to meet their potential and enjoy their learning.
