We have just heard from East Sussex that, after much lobbying from us, Seaford and District Bus Company are planning a new commercial school public bus service from Lindfield and Haywards Heath to Chailey. # Fares Revision

**Fares on most Compass Bus services will be revised from Monday 9th July 2018.**

We have tried hard to keep the fares at the same level since the last change in April 2017, but increasing insurance and fuel costs have meant an increase in most cases.

Services 37, 37B, 740 and 743 remain unchanged, as these services have had a review already this year.

If your current fare is below £1.95, then this will rise by 20p.  
If your current fare is above £2.00, then this will rise by 30p.  
Child tickets, return and weekly tickets will rise in turn.
