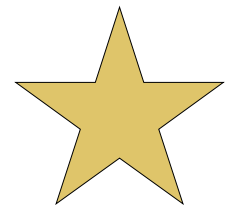


Weekly Message from Mrs Key

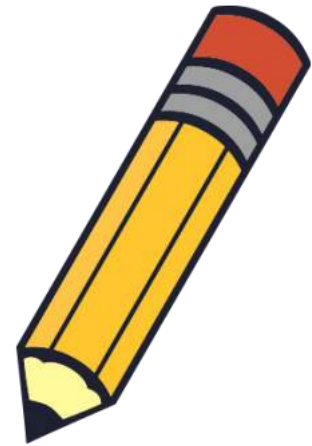

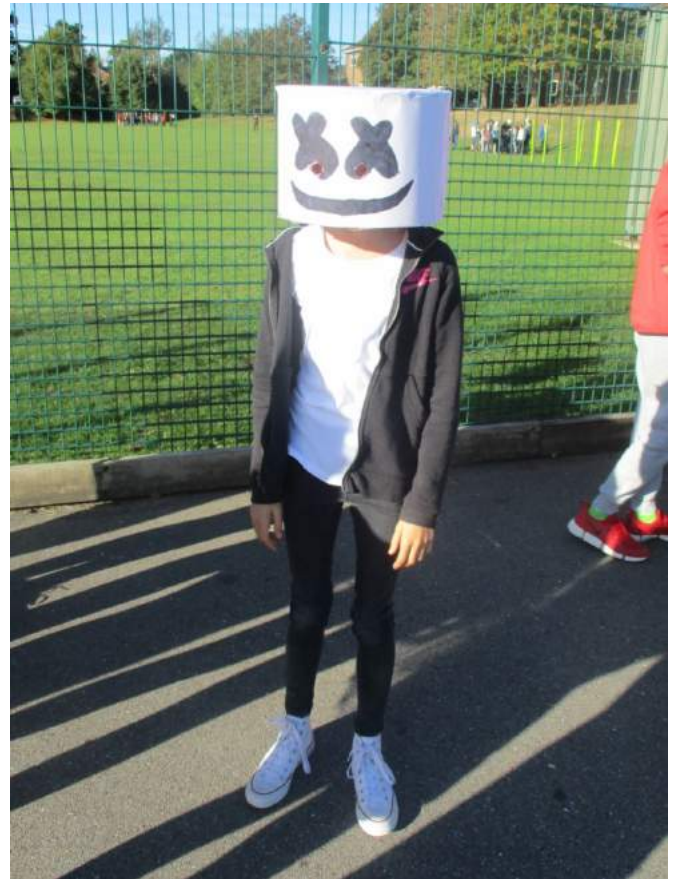

KS4 French Trip to Boulogne



Last weekend a group of KS4 French students visited Northern France along with Ms Milland and Mr Austin. They stayed in Boulogne and visited a bakers where the students got to help make the bread and croissants. They also went to a snail farm and many of the students sampled the snails. The students got a chance to find out about the French education system. The students really enjoyed visiting an authentic French market where they had the task of buying parts of their lunch. There were lots of opportunities for students to try out their French language and sample typical French culture.



“Recently, 16 French-studying students and dual-linguists accompanied by Ms Milland and Mr Austin participated in a 3-day excursion to Boulogne-Sur-Mer in northern France. All in all, as well as having an amazing time, we are all grateful for having an invaluable insight into French culture, whilst improving our speaking, listening and reading in (sometimes fluent) French!”
