May I take this opportunity to thank you all for your support of the school this year and to wish you all a restful and peaceful winter break.



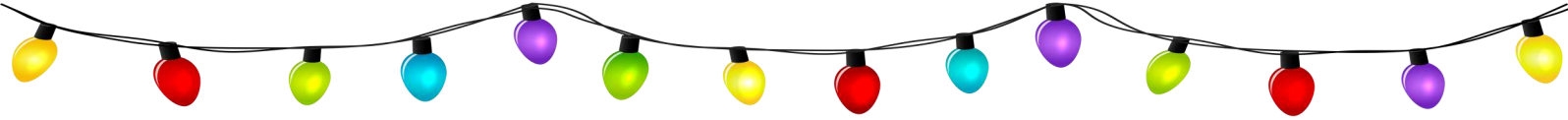

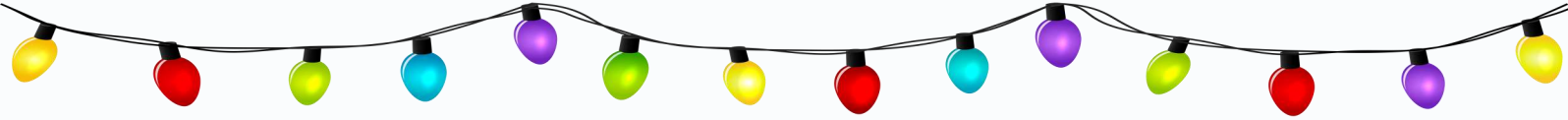
All in all, a very successful day! Thank you to Mrs Rickman and Mr Robinson for helping me look after 29 very well-behaved students.

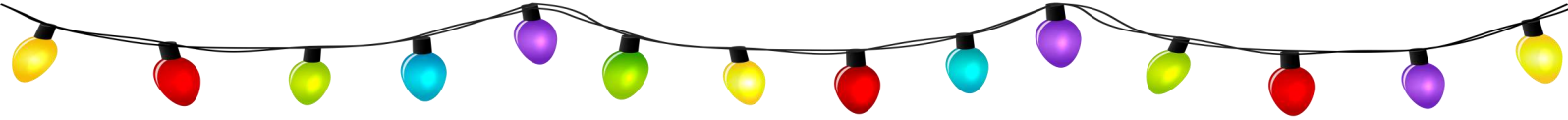
