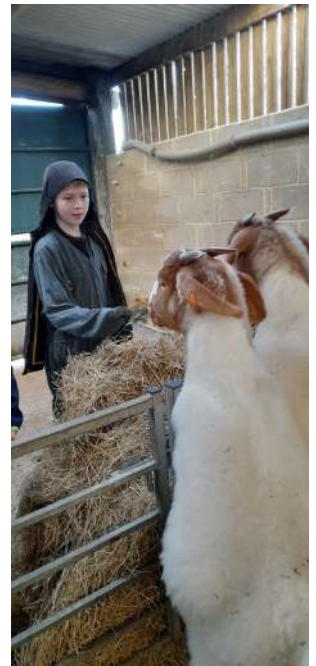
JAMIES FARM VISIT
